**Subject: VP1000 Dispenser Mounted Vacuum Pump**

As the Healy product line continues to grow as the leader in Stage II Vapor Recovery, Franklin Fueling Systems continues to look for ways to increase production capacity and improve delivery times. To meet our objectives, manufacturing of the Healy VP1000 Vacuum Pump has been moved to our Madison, Wisconsin facility. With production moved to the Madison facility, VP1000 part numbers remain unchanged, and orders for this product will continue to ship from the Hudson, New Hampshire facility, but there are a few minor visual differences we want to make you aware of.

The first change you will notice with VP1000's produced in Madison is that they are painted Franklin blue rather than the previously used green. The second change you will notice with VP1000's produced in Madison is the addition of a 'M' at the beginning of the Date Code – Serial Number (DC-SN) on the VP1000 nameplate. Other than the addition of the 'M', the Date Code – Serial Number remains unchanged and breaks down as follows:

**M ww YY xxxxx**

**M** = Madison production facility

**ww** = two digits to indicate Week of manufacture

**YY** = two digits to indicate Year of manufacture

**Xxxxx** = five digits to indicate unique manufacturing Serial Number

For example, VP1000 with DC-SN M010722811 was manufactured in the Madison facility on the first week of 2007 with unique serial number 22811.
